From the Peace & Social Justice (PSJ) Team – Support NORCOR Movement

The Northern Oregon Regional Correctional Facility in Wasco County is a public jail funded by taxpayer dollars from Wasco, Hood River, Sherman and Gilliam Counties. This jail is not equipped to house and care for immigrants who are in custody for being undocumented, which is a civil offense. These people are not serving criminal sentences, rather they are awaiting hearings regarding their immigration status. Such use of public funds is in violation of Oregon’s sanctuary law ORS 181A-820 and is a betrayal of the public trust. The PSJ Team invites you to sign a petition asking the NORCOR board to terminate their contract with Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). PSJ members will be in Brooks Hall after the 10 AM service today to provide more detail and an opportunity to sign the petition.
