Why did Hollywood make a movie about wicked 1920s evangelists in 1960? You might find out during the discussion following *Elmer Gantry* on August 12. Filmsite's review of the film notes that it "is an entertaining melodrama with memorable performances, from writer/director Richard Brooks. It is the controversial telling of Sinclair Lewis' 1927 muckraker novel regarding the charismatically engaging, but scandalous Midwestern salesman turned preacher in the 1920s. The film accurately foretells the actual real-life scandals of many tele-evangelists in the last part of the century, including Jimmy Swaggart, Jim and Tammy Bakker, and Oral Roberts." Starring Burt Lancaster and Jean Simmons, the latter as a movie version of Aimee Semple McPherson, founder of the Church of the Four Square Gospel.
