Our 10:15 service will return to Trinity next week, as we kick off a new program year, welcoming the Choir back, as well as our special program for children. And the weekly forum resumes, as we’ll welcome a special guest, the Rev. Samuel Borbón, Associate Missioner for Latino-Hispanic Ministries for the Episcopal Church (see below).

Centering Prayer — Wednesday @ 4 PM

We will once again take up our weekly practice of Centering Prayer in the Chapel 4 to 5 pm. on Wednesdays. You are invited to join us this first time back or on any Wednesday you can. There is no commitment to attend each week but of course it is encouraged.

We begin with a short candle lighting ritual, opportunity to voice prayer requests, followed with a reading of a psalm. If those who have not experienced Centering Prayer before come, we give a short instruction on what to expect before we get quiet and sit in silence. We conclude with a short reading of a poem or quotation and a brief time for questions or sharing if desired.
