Second Sunday Cinema — NEXT Sunday @ 6 PM

Ordet (1955) means "The Word" in Danish. Considered by many to be one of the most important religious films ever made. Winner of the Venice Film Festival Golden Lion.

Set in 1925, *Ordet* centers on devout widower Morten Borgen and his three sons: Mikkel, married to the pregnant Inger; Anders, lovesick for the daughter of the leader of a local Christian sect; and Johannes, a student driven mad by his religious studies, who thinks he's Jesus. Directed by Carl Dreyer (who also directed *The Passion of Joan of Arc*) the film is stately in its pacing and gorgeous in its black and white cinematography.

Roger Ebert said of *Ordet*, "For the ordinary filmgoer, and I include myself, *Ordet* is a difficult film to enter. But once you're inside, it is impossible to escape."

The movie begins after an introduction at 6:00 and is followed by a discussion. As always, there is free popcorn.


