



### **Second Sunday Cinema — TODAY @ 6 PM**

*Ordet* (1955) means "The Word" in Danish. Considered by many to be one of the most important religious films ever made. Winner of the Venice Film Festival Golden Lion.

Set in 1925, *Ordet* centers on devout widower Morten Borgen and his three sons: Mikkel, married to the pregnant Inger; Anders, lovesick for the daughter of the leader of a local Christian sect; and Johannes, a student driven mad by his religious studies, who thinks he's Jesus. Directed by Carl Dreyer (who also directed *The Passion of Joan of Arc*) the film is stately in its pacing and gorgeous in its black and white cinematography.

The movie begins after an introduction at 6:00 and is followed by a discussion. As always, there is free popcorn.
