### **Rogation Sunday — TODAY @ 8 and 10:15 AM**

The weekdays before Ascension Day (May 30th this year) are traditionally observed as “rogation days,” the Sunday before is sometimes known as “Rogation Sunday.” The word “rogation” comes from the Latin *rogare*, which simply means “to ask.”

During a time of drought, a 5<sup>th</sup> century French bishop invited the entire community to pray to God for favorable seasons and good weather. And this liturgical ‘innovation’ in one diocese became a seasonal tradition for the whole Church, an annual time to ask for God to bless crops and fields.


