Second Sunday Cinema takes a look at loss, music, and spirituality through the personal documentary, *This May Be the Last Time* (2014). Filmmaker Sterlin Harjo investigates his grandfather's death in 1962. As he does so, he learns about the development of the hymn-style of the Seminole and Muscogee community, developed from Scottish hymn-lining and African-American music. The critically praised film combines personal storytelling and deep research on "America's First Music."
