PALM/PASSION SUNDAY: April 14th @ 8 and 10:15 AM

Holy Week begins with Palm/Passion Sunday. Both of the morning services include the blessing of palms, as we recall both Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and the shock of betrayal and crucifixion that quickly follow.

MAUNDY THURSDAY: April 18th @ 5:30 PM (Liturgy @ 6:30 PM)



We'll gather in Brooks Hall on Thursday evening to share a simple meal of the kinds of foods Jesus might have shared with his disciples. After the supper, we recall how Jesus gathered his disciples together to celebrate Passover. In the course of that meal, Jesus showed us how to love one another, getting down on his knees in loving service.

GOOD FRIDAY SACRED WALKS: April 19th @ 12 PM and 1 PM

On Good Friday, we are invited to walk the "Way of the Cross."




The noon service (in St. Helens Hall) retraces the steps Jesus' to the cross. Our wood-carvings at each station invite us to deepen our reflections.

After this service, our labyrinth will be available until 4 pm. It's another way to engage us in a meditative experience of walking with Jesus.

The 2 PM liturgy at Trinity picks up where we left off on Maundy Thursday. This service includes the dramatic reading of St. John's Passion Gospel.

GREAT VIGIL OF EASTER: April 20th @ 8 PM

The services of Holy Week reach their climax with the Great Vigil of Easter. Rich in symbols – fire, darkness and light, baptismal water – together with the stories of our faith and music, this elaborate service celebrates new life!



EASTER SUNDAY: April 21st @ 8 (Trinity) and 10:15 AM (St. Helens)



And, of course, the services on Easter morning will be celebrated with great joy! To mark the occasion, the church will be adorned with flowers for the season. And our Choir will be on hand to help lead the celebration at both of the morning services!
